Requirements:

1. Fill out the information asked for above.
2. Must be a female Arkansas resident of Calhoun, Dallas, or Ouachita County, a United States citizen/lawful permanent resident.
3. Must be an Arkansas high school graduate, be an Arkansas home school graduate, or obtain an Arkansas GED.
4. Must be accepted for admission at SAU Tech as a full-time student in an Associate Degree or Technical Certificate program.
5. Must write and submit a 350 word essay explaining why she wants to further her education.
6. Must include two letters of reference from people unrelated to her. One letter should address the applicant's character, and the other letter should address the applicant's ability to complete the course of study.
7. Must be a continuous degree-seeker.
8. Must maintain a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA).
9. Must remain enrolled full time (12 credit hours per semester) and must complete 12 credit hours each semester.
10. Must meet continuing eligibility criteria to continue to receive the scholarship which is renewable each semester until the recipient earns an associate degree or attempts a total of 60 semester hours in four (4) semesters.
11. Is not guaranteed to receive the scholarship again if lost even if she becomes eligible later.
12. Deadline for applications is August 1 for the fall semester and February 14 for the spring semester.
