Course Title: Art Appreciation

Course Description: A study of the development of Art throughout history with an emphasis on the characteristics of style, period, content, form, and function. The study will also include an overview of all major movements in Art and the artists that emerged.

On-Campus Requirement:

The final exam must be taken at an approved proctor site.

Modes of Interaction: Discussion Board, Online Assignment, Email

Methods of Assessment: 9 quizzes and 4 unit slide exams are given during the course. The Final is a descriptive essay, which will describe the image you will be given using the various aspects you have studied. This essay in length is at least 250 words but not more than 400 words.

Enrollment Procedures:

SAU Tech is an open admissions college; however, we have several items that you must provide in order to be admitted:

- Submit application for admission.
- Submit a high school transcript or GED, and official college transcripts from all previously attended colleges (if applicable).
- Provide proof of two immunizations against measles, mumps and rubella.
- Take a placement test. Students enrolling must submit ACT, SAT, ASSET or COMPASS scores. Students
 can take the ASSET or COMPASS test at SAU Tech.

Students are responsible for all tuition and fees at the time of registration. Students must officially drop by written notice or in person in order to reduce their balance owed. If students never attend class, he/she will still be assessed partial tuition and full student processing fees, unless completely he/she completely withdraws during the 100% refund period.

In order for a student to drop a class, he/she must complete a drop form or send written request to his/her advisor. A \$5 drop fee is assessed for drops that take place after the registration period ends.

So many times errors and questions are not necessary if time would be taken to read and follow directions. Before taking each unit slide exam a paragraph is posted and you must respond to it. Each paragraph is worth 50 points. The slide exams cannot be taken until this paragraph is completed.
