Credit for Prior Learning



Are you a law enforcement officer looking to further your education or complete a degree to advance in your current job? Did you know that SAU Tech offers the Associate of Professional Studies in Law Enforcement degree which enables law enforcement officers in Arkansas to utilize the training received at ALETA toward a college degree? In addition to ALETA credit, an additional 32 credit hours are required to complete the degree.

Are you busy with your current job and don't have the time to commute to SAU Tech? That's okay. This degree is offered completely online, making your education possible and affordable!

Methods of obtaining credit

There are several options to award the ALETA credit that are dependent upon when your ALETA training was completed. Check out the ways we can offer credit to you!

Option 1: You completed the paperwork while at ALETA for basic training. At your completion of the training, the 28 college credit hours were posted to your SAU Tech transcript and you received the Technical Certificate in Law Enforcement.

Option 2: You completed ALETA training prior to the beginning of the partnership with SAU Tech or did not fill out paperwork while at ALETA.

- If you were at ALETA between 1990 and 1996, you will need to enroll in a 1-credit hour course called Portfolio Development. Through this course, you will compile and submit a resume and training certificates including the ALETA certificate showing completion of the training and certificates showing at least 60 hours of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training (CLEST) approved training. The 28 college credit hours are then approved and posted to your transcript.*
- If you completed ALETA since 1997, you will need to present a copy of the ALETA certificate (not certificate from CLEST) showing completion of the training to the academic advisor at SAU Tech. The 28 college credit hours are then reviewed, approved, and posted your transcript.*

* Student is eligible for the 28 college credit hours for ALETA training but will not be awarded the Technical Certificate in Law Enforcement from SAU Tech.

Scholarship Opportunities

Do you need financial support to go to school? We can help! We offer a scholarship just for law enforcement officers!

Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be employed with law enforcement in Arkansas.

Submit *letter from Law Enforcement Agency with application.

2. Applicant must have successfully completed the Arkansas Law Enforcement Training Academy Certification Program.

Submit *copy of certificate with application.

3. Applicant must enroll in the Technology Degree with Law Enforcement Emphasis.

4. Scholarship covers tuition only of college credit courses leading to the Technology Degree with Law Enforcement Emphasis.

5. Applicant must be registered for classes for scholarship to be awarded.

6. Scholarships will be awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis, provided funds are available.
