



TRANSFER GUIDE for Southern Arkansas University Tech (SAU TECH) Associate of Arts with Criminal Justice Emphasis graduates to COLUMBIA COLLEGE (CC) Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice Administration Degree

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this guide is to establish a seamless education plan for students completing the Associate of Arts (AA) with Criminal Justice Emphasis degree at Southern Arkansas University Tech and transferring to the Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice Administration (BA.CJAD) program at Columbia College. All Columbia College courses are available online. **Only grades of "C" or better will be accepted in transfer by Columbia College.** Students must enroll in the Columbia College Associate to Bachelor's program to lock in the academic catalog year and the personalized plan. **NOTE:** Due to possible Columbia College catalog updates, always consult with your Columbia College Associate to Bachelors (A2B) advisor before making final course selections.
