This is a nine-month faculty position that will serve as instructional designer and teach six to nine hours each semester. The Instructional Designer will work under direct supervision of the Vice Chancellor for Academics & Planning and serve as supervisor of the Center for Online Learning. The Instructional Designer provides instructional and program design expertise for the development and support of online courses and specialized educational programs.

- 3. - 6. Assist in promoting quality in course/program structure and faculty development/training and is responsible for ensuring that instructional content and course design meet the guidelines outlined by the college and national standards/best practices.
- 7. Serve as the institution's representative and trainer for Quality Matters.
