

Transfer Credit Policy

Transfer credit may be accepted from students who provide official transcripts from institutions recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation if these credits fit the program of studies selected at SAU Tech and the student received a grade of "C" or better. The Registrar reserves the right to accept or deny transfer credits to SAU Tech based on the transfer institutions academic policies.

Official transcripts should be submitted to the Office of Admissions at the time of application to the University. Official transcripts will be evaluated by the Registrar. Final approval of transfer credits rests with the Vice Chancellor for Academics. Courses accepted for transfer credit will be posted to the student's SAU Tech transcript with the grade earned and the transfer institutions course identifier and title. Transfer credit is not calculated as part of the student's SAU Tech cumulative GPA. Credits earned will only be reflected in hours earned and may be used for degree requirements.

Students must complete a minimum of 15 credit hours of residency to be eligible for an SAU Tech degree.
