**Nursery Attendant (Nursery Worker)**

POSITION REPORTS TO: Children's Director, Pastor, and/or Personnel Committee

POSITION CLASSIFICATION: Regular Part-Time Hourly

POSITION SUMMARY: Reliable workers needed to care for children from birth to sixth grade, while they are in the church nursery or in church childcare. Job will entail approximately 4 paid hours per week. Hours are Sunday evenings for approximately 2 hours and Wednesday evenings for approximately 2 hours.

PAY: \$12.50/hr

**RESPONSIBILITIES AND EXPECTATIONS:**

- Abide by all policies and guidelines of First Baptist Church of Camden at all times, including mask policies.
- Complete Nursery forms as needed and communicate special needs to volunteers and Nursery Coordinator.
- Arrive on time to nursery at least 15 minutes prior to service/activity for which you are scheduled, and stay at least 15 minutes after, or until all children are secured with responsible adult.
- Notify your FBCC point of contact as soon as possible if unable to work a shift, so that other arrangements can be made.
- Ensure safety of nursery environment, i.e. cleaning products and medications stored out of reach of children, outlet covers on electrical outlets, sanitation procedures followed, etc.
- Other duties as assigned.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 18 years of age and no longer in high school.
- Able to pass FBCC's background check.
- Physically capable of working with children from birth to 6<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Be of good moral and Christian character, i.e. responsible, loves and respects our children, honest in all interactions with parents and church staff/volunteers.

**PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Knowledge of age-appropriate needs for children from birth to sixth grade.
- Ability to adapt and interact with a variety of personalities and developmental levels common to children.
- Experience in childcare settings.
- Trained in CPR.
