Alumni Scholarship Deadline: May 31	Be a first-time entering freshman. Have a parent (not SAU Tech employees) or grandparent who graduated from SAU Tech with an Associate's Degree. Have a 2.5 GPA or higher. Submit a 250-word essay on "What becoming a Rocket and receiving an Alumni Scholarship would mean to you." Must enroll in at least 12 hours per semester.	Tuition & Standard Fees for no less than 12 hours per semester	Complete 24 credit hours at year-end and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5. Good for 4 semesters	Complete the scholarship application, self-identify as the child or grandchild of an SAU Tech alumni on the scholarship application, and submit the required essay NOTE: Children of SAU Tech employees are not eligible.

General Scholarship Guidelines:

- SAU Tech scholarships only pay for tuition (in-state only), unless otherwise noted. Only one scholarship awarded per student.
- *ACT, Compass and other assessment scores are accepted as equivalent.
- All applicants must be fully admitted to SAU Tech and degree seeking; must not already have an Associate or Bachelor's degree.
- Applicants must be US citizens or permanent resident aliens.
- Students must enroll in 15 hours each semester unless otherwise notated; must begin attendance in the fall semester.
- Scholarships are awarded on a fall/spring basis. Scholarships cannot be used for summer sessions.
- Scholarship applications must be completed and submitted with items need by the stated date; first to apply will receive preference; waiting list applies after stated date.
- Scholarships are reviewed at the end of the spring semester to determine if renewal requirement met (i.e., "at year end").
- Scholarships are awarded to the extent funds are available.
- Scholarships are good for a total of up to four consecutive semesters or until the student receives an Associate degree, whichever is earlier, provided the student meets renewal requirements. If the student is not enrolled for a semester the scholarship is lost. Depending on the scholarship requirements the student may be able to reapply.

Updated General Guidelines:

Beginning with 2017-2018 recipients, students receiving the Merit Scholarship, Concurrent Award, Student Ambassador Merit Scholarship, and Skills USA Scholarship are allowed to enroll in 12-15 credit hours in the fall and/or spring semester, BUT if students are enrolled in 12-14 hours in the fall and/or spring, they will be REQUIRED to take 3-6 credit hours in the summer (if in 12-14 in fall only 3 in summer, if in 12-14 in fall and spring 6 in summer). If students are enrolled in 15 credit hours per semester, they are required to complete 24 credit hours by year end (no summer required). If students enroll in 12-14 hours in fall/spring, they are required to complete all courses taken including the required summer courses. If in 12-14 hours in fall/spring, scholarship will be awarded at \$1200 for the semester, and the remaining portion will be awarded in summer (example: take 12 hours in fall and spring, award fall - \$1200, spring-\$1200, summer \$600 to still allow a total of \$3000 for the year).
