Award Process:

The Foundation awards scholarships based on the following criteria:

- 1. Application submission on or before the deadline
- 2. Eligibility of each applicant for the scholarships they selected in the application

In cases where one or more applicants meet criteria 1 and 2, the Foundation's Scholarship Committee also considers *GPA*, *ACT*, *high school or community involvement in organizations, and volunteerism, and may also consider financial need.* Applicants are ranked, and awardees are selected on a point system by a committee of faculty, support staff, and administrators at SAU Tech. In the case of a tie, the Foundation staff may participate in award decisions.
